



NAUI ADVANCED SCUBA DIVER COURSE PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION

I. Overview

This course is a continuing education certification course for the certified divers. It is an enjoyable program of continued supervised experience designed to introduce divers to a variety of diving activities and to be taught entirely in an openwater setting. Upon successful completion of this course graduates are considered competent to engage in openwater activities without supervision, provided the diving activities and the areas dived approximate those of training.

II. Prerequisites For Entering The Course

1. AGE. Minimum age is 16 years old.
2. Diver Certification and Prior Training. NAUI SCUBA Diver
3. Health and Fitness. Candidates must provide a certification of good health from a medical professional specifying that they are fit to engage in scuba diving activities.
4. Equipment. Candidates must provide their own Skin and SCUBA diving equipment
5. Watermanship Skills. Non required

III. Course Outline

This course will be taught entirely in an Openwater setting. A maximum of 6 dives is needed to complete the course. There will be a briefing prior to each dive to set the objectives and tasks needed to meet the objectives. Debriefings will follow after each dive. Dives to be performed is Deep Dives, Night Dives, Compass Navigation, Current Diving and Multi-level Diving.
